If you are playing with KOMC, you should have these items as part of your uniform and instrument kit.

If you want to use a vendor besides the one listed, check with the Pipe Major first. You'll save us all time and yourself money.

 - PLEASE don't buy one without checking with the Pipe Major. There is a LOT of junk out there, just like with pipes and drums. If what you buy looks like crap, you won't be able to wear it.

 - Your choice. You don't have to have one.

 - **2** (two) extra BAND chanter reeds that you are working in anticipation of your current reed dying in the middle of a performance. (carry in your sporran during band gigs)
