Chosen by majority vote of the band.

Best "Buddy" This award is given when, during the season, a member exemplifies one or more legendary traits of Buddy McKay. These include, but are not limited to: food stains on a white shirt on a parade day, joining parades enroute, fatigued lips, second-guessing the pipe major, reliability, and good naturedness in all conditions. Awarded with irregularity by the pipe major, who will consider nominations from band members.
